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Ministry of Primary and Secondary Education Expands Access to Deep Learning, Coding, and AI Training for Teachers

JAKARTA, July 10, 2026 — Indonesian teachers now have expanded opportunities to enhance their professional skills. While geographic distances, time constraints, and travel costs have traditionally hindered training, teachers across the archipelago, from Sabang to Merauke, can now learn directly from their schools or homes. This is made possible through the Independent Training for Deep Learning, Coding, and Artificial Intelligence (PM-KKA), available on the Ruang GTK channel within the Rumah Pendidikan application.

Through this digital platform, teachers can access learning modules, videos, and materials guided by facilitators without disrupting their classroom teaching schedules. This initiative is part of the Ministry of Primary and Secondary Education's (Kemendikdasmen) efforts to provide equal access to professional development for teachers, driving the mission to achieve "Quality Education for All."

Minister of Primary and Secondary Education Abdul Mu'ti officially launched the PM-KKA independent training program at the Jakarta Teacher and Education Personnel Center (BGTK) on Thursday, July 9. In his remarks, Minister Mu'ti emphasized that teachers are agents of learning and civilization, making professional development vital to cultivating expert educators.

"Teachers do not just teach to develop students' motor skills or abilities. The lessons taught must carry values and direction that shape character," Minister Mu'ti said. "Great teachers are not those who know everything, but those who are willing to learn everything. Digitalization is the current, and Ruang GTK is the platform for teachers to upgrade their competencies."

Director General of Teachers, Education Personnel, and Teacher Education, Nunuk Suryani reported that the PM-KKA training, which began in 2025, has been significantly strengthened this year. While the initial phase focused on preparation and piloting, this year's primary focus shifts to subject-based implementation. The 2026 program also optimizes the role of Working Groups, such as the Teacher Working Group (KKG) and the Subject Teacher Forum (MGMP), as hubs for instructional innovation.

"We want to ensure that the philosophy of Mindful, Meaningful, and Joyful Deep Learning is truly felt in classrooms, rather than remaining just a concept on paper," Director General Suryani said.



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The 2026 PM-KKA training is delivered through two primary tracks. The first is the In-Person Track, which is conducted offline through Working Group forums using the Teacher Experimental Training (TET) method. This approach transforms schools into learning laboratories where teachers design solutions for real classroom challenges, implement them, and reflect collectively with peers, utilizing the "Teacher Learning Day" policy held once a week.

The second is the Online Track, which is conducted digitally via the Ruang GTK channel on the Rumah Pendidikan application. This online track offers two types of learning, starting with Independent Training that allows teachers to study autonomously at any time and place through modules, educational videos, and webinars led by facilitators. It also includes Blended Training, which is accessed via a Learning Management System (LMS) and designed for teachers who require more structured guidance, combining self-paced LMS learning with live webinars for material reinforcement.

By combining these two tracks, the 2026 PM-KKA training aims to reach more than 300,000 educators and education personnel across 140,000 educational institutions throughout Indonesia.

The Ministry of Primary and Secondary Education remains committed to expanding equal access to high-quality professional development for teachers. Through these accessible online and offline training methods, the ministry aims to help educators master the conceptual foundations of Deep Learning, Coding, and AI. This will ultimately elevate classroom instruction and deliver direct benefits to students across Indonesia.
